Athletic Report: In process of getting numbers for volleyball and Cross country, and finding coaches.

Administrative Report: Status of budget for 23-24 has us in the black \$100,000.00. Working on getting past due tuition balances current.

Principals Report: 7&8 grades were virtual for the 2 hr delay on Monday April 17th. Looking for a new choice auditor. Cindy retirement party June 3rd. Open house style from 1-4. Her last day is July 14th. Eans funds bought a new math curriculum. Bridges will be used in k-5, HMH will be used in 6-8. A new Concordia Religion series will also start next school year, as the one we were using is no longer available. Mr. Tessendorf presented how valedictorian and salutatorian are determined. Slideshow of 3 different methods that can be used, and which one St. Peters uses. A lot of discussion on how St. Peters calculates valedictorian and salutatorian. More discussion to occur in the executive session. We will continue to rent out a classroom to the Reedsburg School District. Showed a chart that talked about enrollment numbers for the 23-24 school year. Information on a 6th grade parent meeting was shared.
