Athletic Report: Fund raising is underway. Approx. \$1000 profit will be made on Seerogy candy bar sales, Upcoming fund-raising events are the Pizza Sale at school and the Rib Fest to be held in August at Viking Village Foods.

Administrative Asst Report: Families who have fallen behind in tuition payments are being contacted twice a month. Our School Auditor will no longer service us for the Choice Audits. A search for a new one is underway. The DPI Hot Lunch Administrative Review will be March 14 & 15.

Principal's report –

Staff is making the final decision on a new Math curriculum. The membership for ADF, (America Defending Freedom) has been established for church & school. The Open House held on February 18 was visited by several families, 1 child enrolled at St. Peter's the following week. Those families that visited will be sent enrollment information once it becomes available.

Snow Day Update – We have used the last of our scheduled snow days. 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> grades will be the only grades that will require additional hours should we have another snow day. In the event that happens, 7&8 grades will be given a packet of instruction to be used for a virtual day, and therefore, meeting the DPI hour requirements.
